Licencing of Crushing Units

MoICE/DoL/LIPD-11/2022-2023/999

The Department of Industry (DoI) noted that some of the licence holders of mining (minerals) in different parts of the country are operating crushing units without an industrial licence. In this regard, the Department would like to notify that a stand-alone industrial licence is required for the operation of crushing units.

For kind information, the licence for SMALL scale crushing units can be obtained from the Regional Offices of MoICE. However, project approval from the Dol, MoICE is required for the issuance of MEDIUM and LARGE scale crushing units. The proponents are required to submit the following documents for approval of the project and issuance of licences for all three categories:

- 1. Business Plan (BP preparation Guidelines could be downloaded from the MoICE website)
- 2. Location Clearance from the relevant local Thromde/Dzongkhag
- 3. Environment Clearance from the Dzongkhag/Thromde for small-scale crushing units and from the Department of Environment and Climate Change (DECC) for medium and large-scale crushing units
- 4. Power Clearance if above 1 MW
- 5. Approved source of Raw materials
